

KEITH & TINTINARA DISTRICT SHOW SOCIETY BARREL RACING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Entry is on the day and closes at 11am, 22nd March, 2014.
2. Successful entry form into the competition does not automatically allow access into event. A ticket must be purchased.
3. This is an application only and does not guarantee the offer of a position.
4. All successful competition entrants must be available to begin competitions at the time specified by K & TDSS organisers.
5. All Utes must be registered and roadworthy to enter the competition.
6. SA road Rules apply and will be enforced throughout the event.
7. Drivers will be breath tested prior to competing. A zero alcohol result will be required for a driver to compete.
8. Drivers assume full responsibility and accept full liability for their own health, well-being, safety, physical actions and the rest of all their actions.
9. K & TDSS Ute Muster event organisers reserve the right to vary the competition.
10. The driver must complete and sign every applicable section of this entry form to be able to complete. Any incomplete forms submitted will not be accepted and driver will not be allowed to compete.
11. Utes must be registered as a utility and must have a tub or a tray (removable canopy allowed).
12. No passengers are allowed. This is a driver only event unless assistance is required due to impairment such as hearing ect.
13. All competitors will wear covered shoes. No thongs or sandals allowed.
14. Seat belts must be worn and properly adjusted during competition.
15. Failure to comply with rules and parking instructions given by Officials will result in automatic disqualification from the competition and forfeiture of any entry fee.
16. The Judge's decision is final.


Note: Terms and conditions must be strictly adhered to.

Competition/Pit Area

1. No alcohol is permitted in the Competition Pit Area during the conduct of this event.
2. The maximum speed of vehicles within the Competition Pit Area is 5kph (walking speed).
3. All Officials must stay behind safety barriers during competition.
4. Qualified medical personal must be on site and in attendance.
5. SA Rural Fire Service must be on site and in attendance with full knowledge of the competition.
6. Entry/Exit point into Competition Area to be clearly marked.
7. Grounds will be wet down by the Officials before and between runs (as required) to eliminate dust.
8. Utes must stick to their defined barrel run and do not touch the barrels during competition. If barrels are dislodged the driver will be given a time penalty.

Judging

1. The event will be judged on the quickest run free from infringements.
2. Judge's decisions are final.
3. The judges will look for competitors respect for public safety.

COMPETITION RULES

Drivers

1. A current, valid Driver's Licence is required and must be produced. Learners permit not accepted.
2. Drivers must exhibit a zero alcohol reading immediately prior to the event. Testing will be conducted by Officials.
3. Seat belts must be worn properly adjusted and worn during competition.
4. Drivers shall wear suitable footwear. Thongs or sandals are not allowed.
5. Passengers are not allowed in the Ute unless required due to the Drivers impairment such as hearing ect... (Only the driver is to be in a competing vehicle).
6. Any Ute failing to keep within the defined competition area whilst competing will be automatically disqualified. Any contact with barricades will result in disqualification.
7. Both driver and passenger doors to be kept 'unlocked' during competition.
8. Drivers will be asked to line up in competition order outside the competition arena and await further instruction Officials.
9. Officials will give each driver a quick debrief before they enter the arena, a horn will sound and the driver will start their run.
10. A horn will sound signalling the end of the run. The competitor is to stop immediately and leave the arena at 5kph (walking pace), prior to the next competitor entering the arena. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.

Competition Vehicles

1. Only vehicles which pass scrutiny will be allowed to compete.
2. Utes must be registered with registration papers in vehicle.
3. All Utes will be checked for safety by Officials. Anything may be dislodged during competition must be removed, (any loose in/on tray, tool boxes must be removed).
4. Competition and demonstrations are restricted to one competing vehicle at a time.
5. Only competing vehicles are allowed in the competition area. The competing vehicle must have the left competition area prior to the next vehicle entering.

I am aware and agree that it is a condition of entry in this activity that my vehicle is roadworthy. I understand that my vehicle will be scrutineered by Officials prior to the event, testing for roadworthiness and safety.

I also represent that I am in a good health and do not suffer from any conditions which would prevent me from participating in the above named activity. These conditions include, but are not limited to, high blood pressure, hernias, pregnancy and heart condition.
