All varieties must be named. No chemically treated grain accepted. Fodder must have roots attached, preferably washed, minimum 6 plants or 3kg.

- 1 Hard wheat (4 litre ice-cream container size)
- 2 A.S.W. or A.P.W.
- 3 Malting barley
- 4 Feed barley
- 5 Milling oats
- 6 Feed oats
- 7 Canola (1 kg only)
- 8 Peas, lentils, chickpeas
- 9 Beans
- 10 Lupins

Classes 11-25 - Must have washed roots included - Min 3 kg bundle

- 11 Bundle of green lupins
- 12 Bundle of green peas
- 13 Bundle of green beans
- 14 Bundle of green wheat
- 15 Bundle of green barley
- 16 Bundle of green lentils or chickpeas
- 17 Bundle of green oats for grain
- 18 Bundle of green oats for hay
- 19 Bundle of green canola for grain
- 20 Bundle of clover or medic, no roots
- 21 Bundle of lucerne (not in flower), no roots
- 22 Bundle of green feed, non legume, no roots
- 23 Bundle of green feed, legume, no roots
- 24 Sod of clover or medic pasture with less than 15 cms growth, grazed, to be judged for feed value and development.

- 25 Sod of mixed pasture with less than 15 cms growth, grazed, to be judged for feed value and development.

26 Collection of six or more bundles of green fodder and grain varieties (no roots)
