1 Jubilee Cake from recipe given:

1 1/2 cups SR flour, 1 level tablespoon butter, 1 heaped tablespoon sugar, 1 egg, 1/2 cup currants, 1/2 cup sultanas, 1 dessertspoon peel, 1/2 cup milk and a pinch of salt. Bake in a moderately hot oven about 30 mins. While cake is warm, ice with a thin icing made from 2 tablespoons icing sugar and milk to mix, sprinkle with coconut.

3 Chocolate log, iced only

4 Boiled fruit cake

Beat butter to a cream and add sugar and beat until dissolved, add beaten egg, then milk. Stir in sifted flour and currants. Half fill paper patty cases and cook in a moderately hot oven for 10 -15 mins.
