Entries will be taken on the day. PIC numbers are required and all competitors or guardians must sign a waiver form.

All competitors MUST be members of the Keith & District Show Society. Membership of \$15 is to be paid at the gate or at the Secretaries Office. Wrist bands must be shown as proof of membership when making entries.

All riders must wear approved helmets, as per E.A.S.A, Pony Club or A.S.H Rules.

All riders must wear correct riding boots.

The Keith & District Show Society will take no responsibility for accidents.

Please report any accidents to the Horse Convener immediately.

Horses competing in Stock Horse ring are expected to hold a SHC official Height Certificate.

NO LUNGING OF HORSES ON MAIN ARENA

Protests must be lodged in writing no longer than 30 minutes after the dispute has arisen, along with \$50. This will be refunded to the competitor if the protest is upheld, otherwise this fee is forfeited.

The Steward reserves the right to remove any exhibit from the ring or the grounds that is considered to be a danger to other exhibitors.

The Committee reserves the right to cancel or alter any event on the program.

Ages of riders as stated in the competition will be taken as at day of Show.

Camping and yards are available on the grounds for competitors who wish to stay overnight. Camping is \$10 per night - Please contact convener to make bookings. Yards are available on the day, on a first to arrive basis, with no charge. **Please note that there will be fireworks on Saturday night. Please attend to your horse(s) to ensure their safety.**

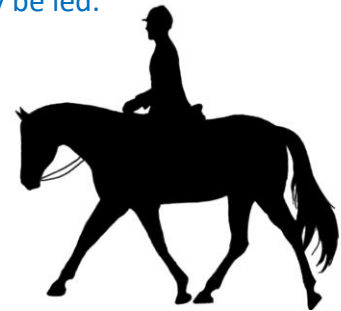

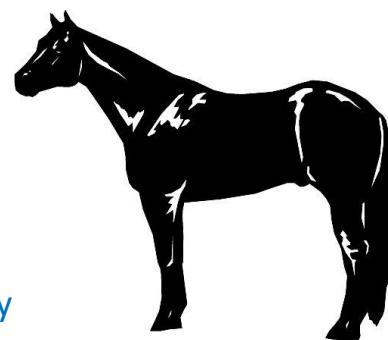
