 - Groups displayed on plates/ silver beet & rhubarb (pulled, not cut at base)
 - Root vegetable - presented with no fine roots attached
 - Herb bundles tied and presented in a neat arrangement and in a jar of water
- It's about neatness & presentation as much as good quality produce.
