Keith Show Horsemanship Challenge

A three part Horsemanship Challenge encompassing a Stock horse dry pattern, horsemanship and obstacle course, and timed obstacle course. Open to all riders and horses of all breeds. A fun event showcasing everyday skills of horsemanship.

Three Events:

1. Junior (rider aged under 18)
2. Novice (competitors who have not won an Open or a Novice Stockman's Challenge)
3. Open

An aggregate competition judged over three parts.

- a. Stock Horse Hack Pattern
- b. Horsemanship and Obstacle Course
- c. Timed Obstacle Course

Parts B and C will be contested over the same obstacles. These obstacles may include everyday tasks and natural obstacles likely to be encountered. Please note they may not be in the same order for both part A and B.

Entry Fee:

1. \$15 Junior
2. \$20 Novice
3. \$30 Open

Ribbons to third place for parts a, b, and c and prize money for Overall Aggregate Winners in all sections
High Point ASH prize sponsored by ASH Society

Rules and Regulations

1. All competitors must be members of the Keith and Tintinara District Show Society, no other memberships or registrations required
2. Horses must compete in a Snaffle Bit Only. Tie downs, martingales, running reins, drop nosebands, and riding whips are prohibited from competition.
3. Stallions must be handled by an adult over the age of 18 years, and tied up with a halter and neck strap.
4. A competitor may compete in the junior section if they are aged under 18
5. All competitors to participate in the spirit of good will
6. Judges decision is final
7. The same rider must compete the horse in all three sections. A competitor may compete on multiple horses, but a horse may not compete in multiple sections with the same or different rider. At all.
8. Dress code is neat casual attire. Approved helmets must be worn, riding boots and jeans or jodhpurs.
9. No unrestrained dogs to be permitted on the showgrounds.
10. It is recommended that all riders and handlers have their own personal accident insurance and Ambulance Cover.
11. A Risk Waiver must be signed before entries are accepted.
12. Committee reserve the right to alter the program without notice.

JUDGING

Section A will be judged under ASH Stock Horse rules, using ASH Stock Horse Patterns.

In the case of equality of points for the aggregate, the result will be determined by the fastest timed obstacle course.
