- Entries will be managed at the Show Office on Saturday (29th March 2025) from 8:15am.

- All dogs not competing MUST be on a lead with a handler, in the marshalling area behind the competition area AT ALL TIMES.

- Only ONE dog may be loose within the competition area at any given time.

- There MUST be a handler at the top of the jump to act as a catcher if necessary, & a handler at the bottom as the 'catcher' as well. It is the responsibility of the dog owner to supply their extra handlers.

- Each dog is ALLOWED three attempts at each height if necessary.

- In the event where two dogs are jumping at the same height, the winner shall be determined by the dog that took the LEAST NUMBER of attempts from one jump.

- A dog may be able to compete on a loose lead, or, must be released at a minimum of THREE METRES from the jump. If, in the opinion of the Stewards, believe that a dog is unsafe to other dogs, handlers & the general public, it will be withdrawn from the competition IMMEDIATELY.

- Waivers must be signed prior to commencement of competition (see regulation 22).

IMPORTANT TO REMEMBER:

- The breed, shape, sex & colour of the dog are NOT taken into account.

- Muzzles may be worn.

- Any mishandling and/or misuse of a dog will result in IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION.

- All competing dogs must have been vaccinated against canine distemper, canine infectious hepatitis, & canine parvo virus within the previous 12 months, but no later than 2 weeks prior to competition.

- A certificate must be presented if requested by the convenor.
